Thunder Bay District Golf Hall of Fame Information

The Thunder Bay District Golf Hall of Fame was created in 2007 and is located inside the clubhouse at Chapples Golf Course.

The Hall of Fame is administered by the TBDGA under the direction of our Hall of Fame Committee. The Hall of Fame honours two categories of individuals:

- 1. Players for their significant on-course achievements; and
- 2. Builders for their contributions to the game of golf in the Thunder Bay District.

Information about Player Nominees

- The nominee may qualify in any of the following classes: Amateur Player, Professional Player, or Overall Career. However, individuals are limited to one (1) induction as a Player, regardless of class.
- The nominee must have a minimum of one (1) win among our "major" championships (i.e., the District Open, the District Amateur, and the Strathcona Invitational).
- The nominee must have a minimum of five (5) individual wins within the Thunder Bay District. Wins in team events are only supportive.
- In exceptional circumstances, where the nominee has achieved profound success outside of the Thunder Bay District, the minimum win requirements may be waived.
- The nominee must be at least five (5) years removed from their last victory.
- No special achievement or performance will garner automatic induction (e.g., winning the Canadian Amateur Championship).
- The nominee must be in good standing with the TBDGA.

Information about Builder Nominees

- The nominee must have a minimum of five (5) years of service in promoting, volunteering, administering, or otherwise making exceptional contributions to the game of golf in a non-playing capacity. Please note that years of service are not alone a criteria for admission. The nominee must have made clearly defined contributions to the game
- Relevant fields include, but are not limited to, administrators, volunteers, and golf professionals.
- The nominee may be active or retired from service.
- The nominee must be in good standing with the TBDGA.
- On-course achievements will not be recognized in this category. However, in exceptional circumstances, an individual may be inducted as both a Player and a Builder.

General Information about Nominees

- The nominee must have, at one time or another, been a resident of the Thunder Bay District.
- The nominee must be at least thirty (30) years old at the time of their nomination.
- Any deceased individual becomes eligible for nomination immediately upon their passing.
- An individual may be nominated as a Player ten (10) times and as a Builder ten (10) times. Any further nominations for that individual will not be considered in the expired category.

Information about the Selection Process

The TBDGA welcomes nominations from the public. Please submit nominations to Andy Karanasos at president@tbdga.com.

All nominations must be completed on the prescribed form, which is found below. All nominations must be signed by two nominators who are not related to each other.

Nominations that are not completed on the prescribed form, are not signed by two nominators, or fail to meet the minimum criteria, noted above, will not be considered.

Nominations must include the contact details of the nominee (if applicable) and both nominators.

Nominations must be received by May 31 for consideration in that year's selection process.

Once received, all nominations will be forwarded to the Hall of Fame Committee. The Committee meets annually to review nominations and vote on inductions. Voting will take place confidentially in July of each year. Voting shall be based upon the nominee's overall resume, integrity, sportsmanship, and character. In any given year, a maximum of four (4) individuals may be inducted into the Hall of Fame.

Please note that the Hall of Fame Committee, on behalf of the TBDGA, reserves the right to add, delete, amend, or waive, without notice, any of the rules regarding the Thunder Bay District Golf Hall of Fame.
